The Oberaigner Group develops and manufactures high-speed drive systems for small series and assembles its own innovative all-wheel drive technology according to automotive standards for commercial vehicles of tomorrow's leading automotive brands. In the segment of all-wheel drive transfer cases, Oberaigner has many years of extensive specialized knowledge and know-how and is able to develop and produce customer-specific products for the automotive industry. As a specialist for small series up to series with medium quantities, Oberaigner fully realizes other vehicle variants and transmission systems for niche applications whose special requirements are not covered by the standard product range of the vehicle manufacturers. The field of application ranges from vans to trucks, passenger cars and buses as well as boats.

A time-consuming manual access management as the starting situation

The manual access assignment using the ticket system became increasingly confusing and time-consuming. If an employee needed a new access permission, a ticket had to be created

that went directly to the IT department. The task of the IT administrators was now to obtain the information to approve the access permission and, once approval had been granted, to set the NTFS permission via Windows board tools. The whole process was documented in the ticket. If an overview of granted access rights was required within the scope of a certification, which is necessary for the customers of the Oberaigner Group, this information had to be taken from the various tickets or folders in the data structure. The reviews were thus extremely laborious and time-consuming, which had to be changed.

Searching for a practical solution

The project team, consisting of key users, IT and the project manager, was looking for a convenient, comprehensive solution to better control access rights management in the future and to simplify evaluations with regard to certifications. In doing so, they researched the market for various providers. Three of these providers, including the software solution from the Darmstadt-based software manufacturer BAYOONET AG, which has been active on the market since 2001, were examined more closely. The decision was clear. «*The BAYOOSOFT Access Manager was exactly what we wanted,*» recalls Hubert Springer, Head of IT & Building Services.



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After the project team was able to convince itself of the software solution through a webinar and the subsequent test installation, the go-ahead was given for the start of operations.



First, the project members used the NTFS Permission Analyzer to obtain an overview of the existing NTFS permissions. Then the data owners were defined, who would later decide autonomously on permission requests in their area. From now on, this role was assumed by the department managers, who received training on rights management, in particular also on the assignment of rights using profile groups, during the later course of the go-live. Before the identified access permission situation could be migrated to the Access Manager, the data managers made appropriate changes to bring the data structure up to date. The migration started with the IT folders and then the software solution was rolled out to all other departments at the location in Nebelberg. This turned out to be straightforward thanks to the energetic support of the Solution Engineer, the primary contact person on the part of BAYOOSOFT. The other two locations, Laage and Ottnang am Hausruck, decided against adapting the existing structure and started from scratch. This means that the folder structure from Nebelberg was taken over and

the access permissions were reassigned according to the Need-to-Know Principle.

The everyday work with the BAYOOSOFT Access Manager

The introduction of the BAYOOSOFT Access Manager has sustainably relieved the IT department. The central component Self Service Portal involves the end users and data managers directly in the access rights management process, so that these requests are processed and documented without IT. The users apply for their access permissions themselves and the data managers can decide on the requests at the click of a button. «*With the help of the Access Manager, access management became a real no-brainer and has taken an enormous amount of work off our shoulders in the IT department.*», praises Hubert Springer. «*Reviews are now no longer difficult laborious tasks, but done at the push of a button.*» In addition, the Access Manager offers further advantages that the project team had not even considered at the beginning. For example, it is possible to store data protection classifications for folders so that it is clear which resources contain or process personal data or how their content must be handled with regard to deletion deadlines. The so called Autocorrection of Permissions also prevents the re-growth of confusing structures, better known as "historically grown". The Self Service Portal turned out to be particularly helpful. «*It is the most useful thing for us in our daily work, because IT just makes sure that the program runs and the rest is done by the users themselves, including the documentation.*», Hubert Springer reports enthusiastically. The problem of the rights hero was also solved satisfactorily. The trainees now only receive

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the access rights they really need, time-based and automated by the software solution.



In summary, the use of the Access Manager at the Oberaigner Group is a complete success. Not only the project team was convinced quite quickly, but the software solution also does an outstanding job in everyday work with access management.
